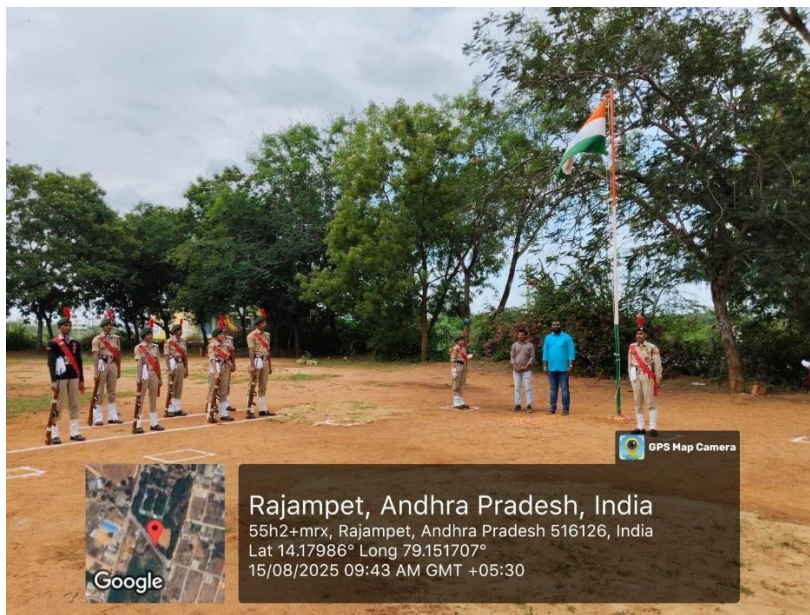
NCC ACTIVITIES FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2025-26

Indian Constitution Day (Samvidhan Divas) is celebrated every year on **November 26** to mark the adoption of the Constitution of India in 1949.

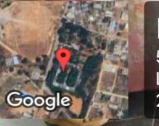
