In the first year — 2022-23 the campaign is "all about understanding and recognising the inequities in cancer care around the world". This day was celebrated combined with Dept.Of Zoology. Dr.B.Purusotham, Principal of this college said "In India, the number of healthcare providers available to **treat cancer** is inadequate considering the large number of cancer patients. We have only around 4000 oncologists for our entire 1.3 billion population. Most of the cancer care centres are overcrowded and patients wait for a long period to get their treatment."
