

This temple has four Raja Gopurams, which stands in four directions. Gali Gopuram was built by Someswara III in the 12th Century. South facing Gopuram was built during the Vijayanagara period. Mandapam inside the temple is built on 108 pillars. Inscriptions on Pillars explains Bhagavatham. The main idol Sri Soumaynatha Swamy is facing towards East

The Idol here resembles the Idol of Sri Venkateswara Swamy in Tirumala Hills, the only difference is that the main Idol is in '*Abhaya Hastham*' whereas in Tirumala the Lord is in '*Kati Varada Hastham*' posture.

Great Poet Annamayya praised Sri Soumyanatha Swamy with 16 of his Sankeertanas.

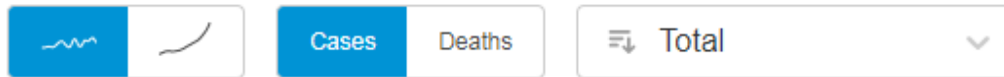

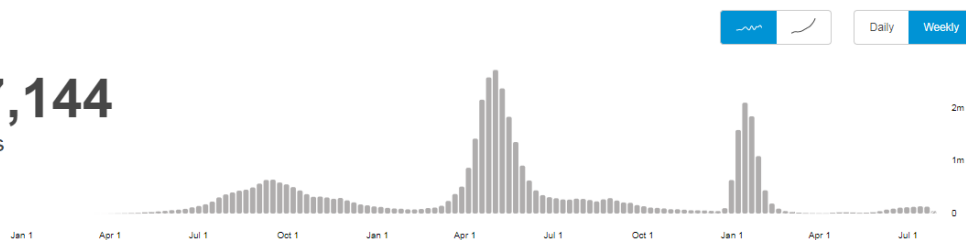


OVERVIEW OF COVID-19:



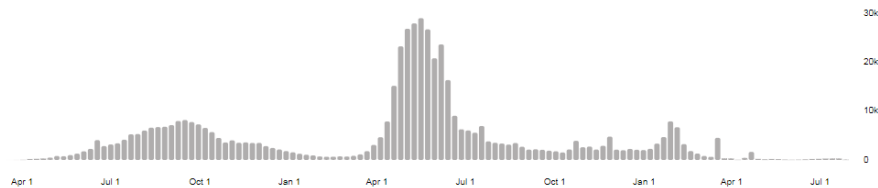
India Situation

4.1 PREACUTIONS FOR COVID-19:
