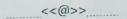
- 1. It is mandatory for all the students to complete Short term internship either in 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester.

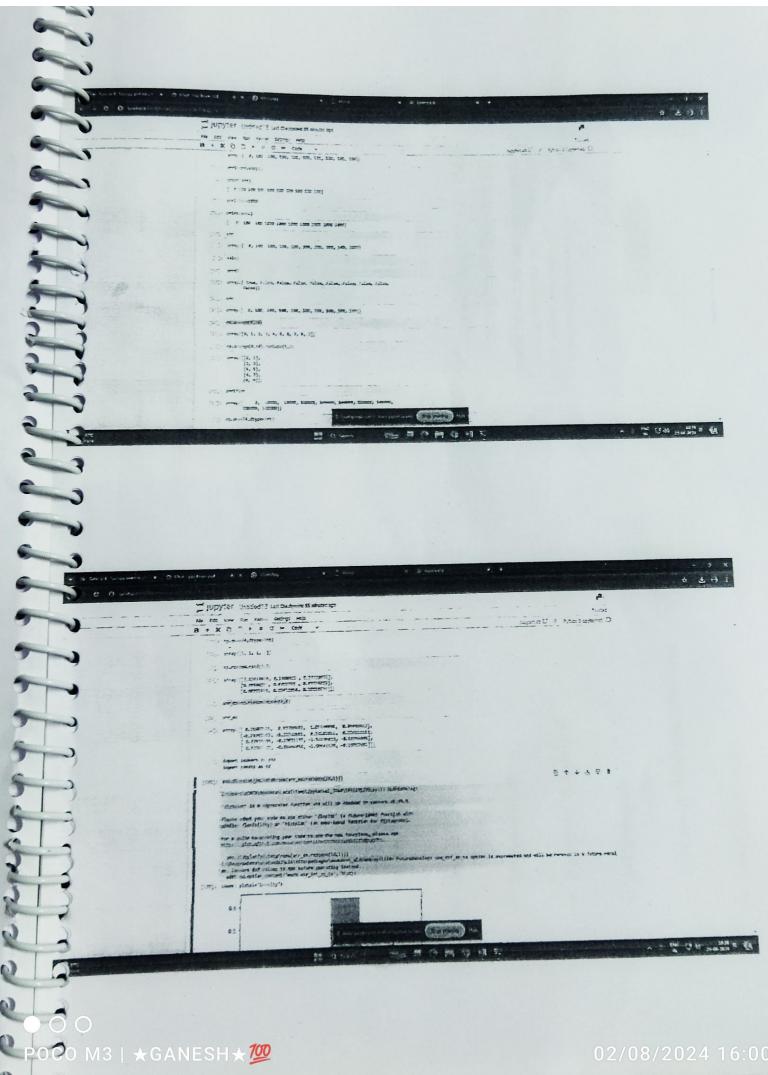
